Star FK Radium Announces Release of *Blue Siberia* and West Coast Tour

Washington, DC, February 15, 2010 – Today Star FK Radium released its first full-length album, *Blue Siberia*, which offers an emotional experience reminiscent of an aural landscape where life is simple, beautiful and perhaps bleak. The instrumental trio consists of classical violin (Alissa Taylor), acoustic guitar (Bill Martien) and drums (Matt Clarke). Star FK Radium creates a composite musical genre that draws on classical chamber music and acoustic rock. In describing the tracks, drummer Matt Clarke says, “the guitar and drums push your mind up to a higher level, while the violin pulls some feeling out of you.”

Blue Siberia was recorded and produced by the internationally acclaimed Jason Rubal. Rubal has produced such artists as the Dresden Dolls (US) and Bitter Ruin (UK). “The music of Star FK Radium may be the most haunting I have ever done, while at the same time the most comforting,” Rubal reflects, “Surely one of the most intense records in my career.”

Star FK Radium is planning a west coast tour for March 2010 to promote *Blue Siberia*’s release. The trio will appear in Seattle (Friday 3/12, Lyon’s Den), Portland (Saturday 3/13, Jade Lounge), Ashland (Sunday 3/14, Liquid Assets), San Francisco (Tuesday 3/16, Hotel Utah Saloon), and San Diego (Friday 3/19, Javanican House). *Blue Siberia* is anxiously awaited by fans internationally. Star FK Radium’s first two EPs sold across five continents.

Star FK Radium’s style incorporates a unique blend of classical chamber music and modern alternative rock, tentatively termed by Patrick Skelly, fan and freelance writer for Paolucci Communication Arts *The Hot Sheet*, as “chamber rock.” “Or alterna-world-beat-classical?” says Skelly, “It’s tough to typecast Star FK Radium.”

Bill Martien, Matt Clarke and Alissa Taylor formed Star FK Radium in June of 2008, and have performed live across eleven U.S. states to date.
